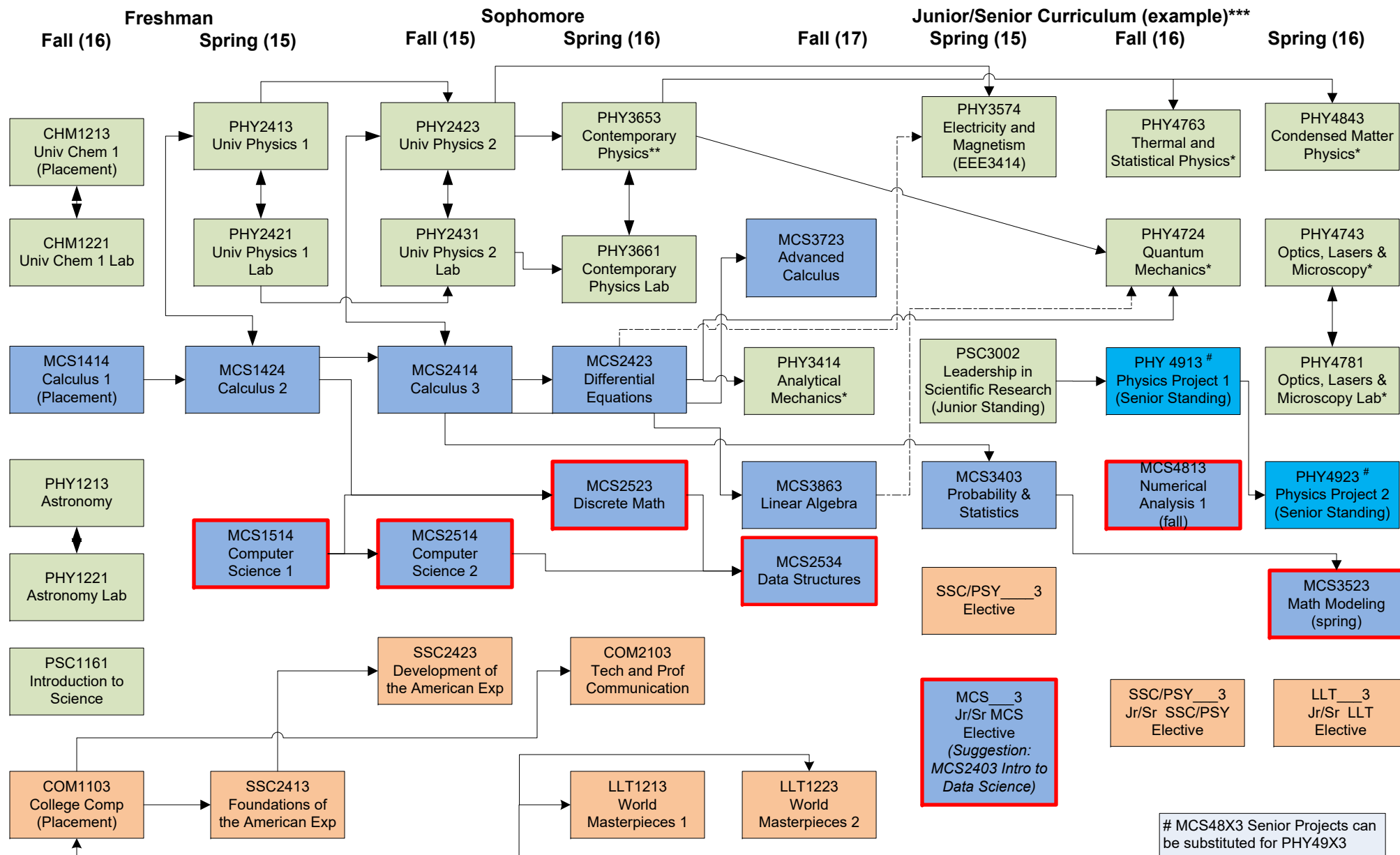


# Bachelor of Science in Physics – Concentration in Computer Science (126 credits)



\* Courses marked with an asterisk are offered every two years and must be taken when offered in order to graduate in a timely fashion.

\*\* PHY3653 must be taken in the Spring term of the Sophomore year in order to provide the proper prerequisite for courses in the Junior/Senior years.

\*\*\* An individual plan of work leading to the degree will be established in consultation with the student's advisor no later than the Fall of the junior year.

→ Leftmost course is prerequisite

↔ One course is co-requisite to the other

(Placement): Requires passing score on placement exam
