



Lawrence Technological University Construction Safety Research Center Bylaws

ARTICLE I. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Lawrence Technological University Construction Safety Research Center (hereinafter called "Center") is a cooperative effort between Lawrence Technological University (hereinafter called "University") and members from industry, government, and academia (hereinafter called "Members").
- 1.2 The purpose of the Center will be to primarily perform academic research.

ARTICLE II. OPERATIONS

The Center will be operated exclusively by the University under advisement by members as a consortium integrating industry, government, and academia. The industrial community may include, but is not limited to, major corporations, middle market companies, small businesses and startups. Pubic participants may range from local governments to divisions of federal agencies.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERS

- 3.1 A company, corporation, or other organization becomes a Member by executing a "Membership Agreement" between the University and Member.
- 3.2 There will be an Industry Advisory Board (hereinafter called "IAB") composed of one (1) designated representative from each member. The IAB will primarily make recommendations on (a) the academic research projects to be carried out by the CENTER, (b) changes to bylaws, and (c) other supporting activities of the CENTER.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICES

- 4.1 The principal office of the Center shall be located at the University's principal place of business (21,000 W. Ten Mile Rd, Southfield, MI, 48075) or such other place as determined by the University.
- 4.2 The Center may have other offices, either within or without the State of Michigan, as the University may designate from time to time.

ARTICLE V. MEETINGS

- 5.1 The Center plans to conduct at least two (2) IAB meetings per year for the purposes of acquiring IAB recommendations regarding academic research projects, changes in bylaws, and activities of the Center.
- 5.2 Meetings of the IAB will be held at the University's principle place of business as defined above. Alternatively, meetings will be held at another location or virtually as determined by the University.

ARTICLE VI. AMENDMENTS

- 6.1 Amendments to these Bylaws will be made as the sole discretion of the University.
- 6.2 The IAB may recommend to the University amendments to the bylaws.

ARTICLE VII. CERTIFICATION

An original, or a copy of these Bylaws, as amended or otherwise altered to date will reside with the University.
