Mac OS X 10.5+ LTU Network connection instructions

- 1. Close any open browsers. (Opera, Firefox, Chrome, etc.)
- 2. Click on the *wireless icon* in the upper right of your screen in the menu bar. Choose LTU Network from the list.
- 3. A new window opens. You must enter your LTU Computer login name and password then click OK.



4. A new window opens, asking you verify the LTU Network certificate. Click Continue.



- 5. A new window opens; you must enter your LTU Computer login name) and password. (for non-LTU computers, enter your computer username and password for that computer) Click OK.
 - If you are having difficulty entering in your LTU Computer login name and password, try
 deleting the network login keychains. (Direction in the box on the bottom of the page)
- 6. A new window opens; you must enter your LTU Computer login name and password. Click OK.



Type your password to make changes to you Certificate Trust Settings.

7. If the internet browser does not automatically open in a few minutes, open it. If you see the Welcome to LTU Network page in the browser, enter your LTU Computer login name and password and press *Submit*.



- 8. If you do not see the Welcome to LTU Network login page, close your browser and re-open it. Try to navigate to Google by typing google.com in the address bar and hit enter. It may take several attempts.a. If you see a page that says "Yes, I will install the Policy Key....", instead of the Welcome
 - to LTU Network login page, see directions for installing the Policy Key at the bottom of the page.
 - b. If you see the Welcome to LTU Network page in the browser, Go back to Step 7.
 - c. If you see the Google homepage in the browser, **Congratulations! You are connected to the wireless network**. Happy computing. No other steps are necessary.
- 9. Close your browser and re-open your browser. Navigate to Google by typing google.com in the address bar and hit enter.
- 10. If you see the Google homepage in the browser, **Congratulations! You are connected to the wireless network**. Happy computing. No other steps are necessary.

Deleting LTU Network Keychains

- Open spotlight in upper right of your screen in the menu bar. Type "keychain" in the search box click on Keychain Access.
- 2. Anew window opens. Select login in the Keychain Access window.



- 3. Select and delete **ONLY** those keychains that are **related** to **LTU** or **GoDaddy**. To delete, select the keychain and press delete on the keyboard .If prompted, enter your LTU Computer login name and password. Repeat until all related keychains are deleted.
