 - Collaborative Programming (either with other Greek organizations, community partners or members of the LTU community)
 - Leadership Opportunities for members/campus
 - Organization Goals - Were they established? Did you achieve them?
 - Involvement on campus (Greek Council, LTU Student organizations, etc.)

Chapters may submit additional supporting documents such as pictures, posters, flyers or awards. Chapters do not have to include supporting documents but may if they feel that it is necessary for their application. If you have a question about a supporting document, please ask the Greek Life Advisor.

Essay requirements:

- 12 point font
- Times New Roman
- Double spaced
- No more than 5 pages in length, may be shorter.

Essays and supporting documents (if included) are due to the Greek Life Advisor, Marissa (mgonzale1@ltu.edu) by **April 19th, 2023 at 9am**. Applications that do not meet the above guidelines will not be read and will not qualify for the award. Applications must be emailed.
