IF A LAWRENCE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY GLO IS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF RECRUITMENT POLICIES:

- **1.** The New Member must drop the New Member process immediately.
- 2. Organization and individual must provide documentation to Greek Life Advisor stating the official removal of that individual from the organization's New Member process 1 week after notified.

IF THE LTU GLO DOES NOT OBLIGE, THE FOLLOWING SANCTIONS WILL BE ENFORCED:

- **1.** GLO loses their recruitment rights for the following semester.
- Greek organization is no longer a recognized organization at Lawrence Tech University.

Greek Life Recruitment Policies



Office of Greek Life Recruitment Policy

An individual interesting in joining a Lawrence Tech Greek Life Organization (GLO) must meet the following criteria:

- Is a full-time Lawrence Tech undergraduate student.
- Has filled out the New Member Interest form.
- Meets the GPA requirement:
 To join a Fraternity or Sorority you must have a 2.0 cumulative GPA. Incoming First Year students must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA based on high school transcripts.

Lawrence Tech Greek Life Organizations may not bid/pledge/recruit/intake/initiate an individual below the GPA requirement.

HAZING

Hazing, defined as an act that endangers the mental or physical health or safety of a student, or which destroys or removes public or private property, for the purpose of initiation, admission into, affiliation with, or as a condition for continued membership in a group or organization. The express or implied consent of the victim will not be a defense. Apathy or acquiescence in the presence of hazing are not neutral acts; they are violations of this regulation. Hazing is forbidden by the policies of the University, by State law, and by each organization recognized by Lawrence Technological University.

General Recruitment Policies:

BOOTH ROTATION

Organizations will be allowed to start setting up their booths at noon on the Sunday Recruitment starts and the booths must be removed before 6:00 pm on the last Sunday of Recruitment

If the booths are not removed by the specified time the Greek Council may levy a fine of \$50.00 per day.

The booth rotation shall move in this order based on the placement of the previous Recruitment:

- Clockwise for the Sororities
- Counter-clockwise for the Fraternities

BIDDING OR PINNING

GLOs may not bid or pin until the first Friday of recruitment weeks



MIXER RULES

Refer to the FIPG Risk Management Policy that is adopted by the Office of Greek Life as of January 2013.

Organizations are responsible for what happens at their mixer.

There shall be no consumption of alcohol during the duration of the mixer.

For a member consuming alcohol during the duration of the mixer, the following actions will be taken:

- 1st Offense: The person(s) involved as well as the President of the organization must meet with Judicial and Greek Advisor
- 2nd Offense: The person(s) involved as well as the President of the organization meet with Greek Advisor and the Dean of Students and will not be allowed to participate in the following semester's recruitment
- 3rd Offense: Removal from Greek Council and not allowed to petition to return until a full calendar year

MIXER ROTATION

Determined by the President and Judicial of Greek Council

Swapping is allowed as long as all parties involved agree.

The GLOs must fill out the Mixer Date Swapping form and have it turned into the Office of Greek Life at least one week prior to the start of Recruitment.
