□ WF Policy: a WF grade indicates failure due to non-attendance. It counts in the GPA as an "F" grade. Please check the registrar's website for dates and policies on withdrawing from a course if you do not plan on attending. https://www.ltu.edu/registrars_office/add-drop-withdrawal-period.asp
□ Academic standing requires a 2.0 GPA or above. To remain in good academic standing, a student must maintain a minimum 2.0 semester GPA. Please note, certain programs require a GPA of 3.0 to advance into the graduate portion of the curriculum.
□ Financial Aid recipients: You will need to maintain a 2.0 GPA or above and successfully complete 67 percent of credits you are enrolled in by the financial aid lock-in date in order to maintain satisfactory academic progress for financial aid.
