## 2024 EXECUTIVE BOARD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

### ELIGIBILITY

#### **Student Government President:**

- Must be a student currently enrolled at Lawrence Tech
- Must have completed at least 60 credit hours toward a Baccalaureate degree
  - 30 hours must have been completed at Lawrence Tech
- Must have at least a 3.0 GPA on the 4.0 grade point system

#### **Student Government Vice-President:**

- Must be a student currently enrolled at Lawrence Tech
- Must have completed at least 30 credit hours toward a Baccalaureate degree
  - 15 hours must have been completed at Lawrence Tech
- Must have at least a 2.7 GPA on the 4.0 grade point system

### APPLICATION & ELECTION PROCESS

#### **Deadline to Apply – Monday, April 1<sup>st</sup> @ 11:59pm**

- Nomination Petition consisting of *50 endorsements (signatures)* must be submitted (digitally) to the current Student Government Election Committee at [kkroll@ltu.edu](mailto:kkroll@ltu.edu)
  - Please use this [file](#) as a template, make a copy, and use your party name as the file name.

#### **Campaigning Begins – Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> @ 12:01 am**

- All candidates will be screened for eligibility before approval to begin campaign
- All campaign materials must be approved by the Division of Student Affairs
- All campaign materials must be taken down by the end of the election week

#### **Candidate Debate – Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> @ 12:30 pm**

- Updates will be posted as we move closer to campaign week
- Candidates will be emailed with details

#### **Election Day – Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup> from 12:01am to 11:59pm**
