Academic Integrity

- Academic integrity and honesty are basic core values of Lawrence Technological University
- Maintains value and reputation of your LTU degree
- Different from culture to culture
- The most common problem for international students is plagiarism
- Academic dishonesty is not tolerated by LTU
- Consequences of academic dishonesty might include an F grade and loss of legal nonimmigrant status as a student

How to Maintain Academic Integrity

- It is important to understand expectations related to academic integrity in the U.S.
- There are a variety of resources to help assist students in learning the expectations
- Know your rights if you are accused of academic dishonesty

Always remember academic dishonesty can affect your ability to make continued academic progress and/or result in dismissal from LTU. This could lead to loss of legal non-immigrant student status. In other words, you may no longer be allowed to study in the United States.

If Found in Violation of the Academic Honor Code:

- First Violation: the student will receive an F grade in the course. This grade will not be recomputed for GPA purposes. The department chair or dean of the college will notify the student in writing of the decision. A copy of the letter will be put in the student's academic record and disciplinary file.
- Second Violation: Expulsion from the University
